Ceremony to dedicate four new Avenue of Honour Trees

Wallan's Avenue of Honour has proudly stood for 100-years. However, over time a number of trees have been removed. As part of the Wallan Town Heart project, we committed to restoring the Avenue of Honour to 53 trees.

We've planted a number of new trees in recent years and the time has now come to replace four of the ageing trees.

We're planting four mature replacement trees grown from the budwood of the original avenue trees to carry on the legacy.
