- A permit for a shipping container will **NOT** be approved for a period greater that six (6) months. If the shipping container is to be kept longer than 6 months the applicant should apply for a building permit for permanent siting of the shipping container during the period of temporary placement. An extension to this permit is unlikely to be granted.
