APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

- Completed application form
- Application fee, which is non-refundable if permit refused
- Site plan showing placement of item including measurements and proximity to neighbouring properties
- Public Liability insurance of a minimum of \$10 million
- Any Covenants or agreements relating to the title of the land

CONDITIONS

- If approved, a Permit will be issued with conditions.
Failing to comply with conditions in a permit issued under the *Community and Environment Local Law 2022* is an offence. Infringements can be issued.
- Failure to fully provide the required information will result in my application being returned and a delay in processing.
- The applicant understands that the personal information provided is to assess your application and record your permit and that he or she may apply to Council for access to and/or amendment of the information. Requests for access and or correction should be made to the Local Laws Department.
- A permit for a shipping container will **NOT** be approved for a period greater than six (6) months. If the shipping container is to be kept longer than 6 months the applicant should apply for a building permit for permanent siting of the shipping container during the period of temporary placement. An extension to this permit is unlikely to be granted.
